The WWF, the WI and the Cooperative Bank joined forces to campaign for increased regulation on hazardous man made chemicals in forthcoming EU chemicals legislation known as REACH. Chris Huhna welcomed the support shown by the WI Members, saying:

£87,000+ for West End

Cllr David Goodall reports: Local Area committee meetings are normally well attended for the planning items, particularly unpopular ones. However, by the end of the meeting the number of people normally drops, but the number of interesting items does not. The meeting at the end of December 2004 was no exception to this. The committee approved funding for projects which would directly benefit residents living within West End Parish. They are:

- £2,500 to be allocated to improve library provision for the elderly and sight impaired;
- £9,116 to be allocated to improve child/youth provision at Bamsland Recreation Ground;
- £2,979 to be allocated towards the installation of acoustic panels in the main hall of the Hilldene Centre;
- £25,461 to be allocated for local transport initiatives to include installation of three bus shelters, replacement of a strategic network of parish seating, upgrade of cycleway, upgrade of lighting and to fund Traffic Regulation Orders associated with operation of major events at Hampshire Rose Bowl;
- £7,050 to be allocated to West End Copse to inhibit motorcycle access and create a woodland seating area;
- £37,500 to be allocated for a dual use basketball/football area at Townhill Junior School;
- £3,000 to be allocated to Townhill Farm Community Centre for essential roof repairs.

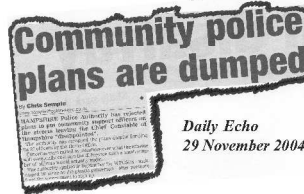
2,190 Post Offices closed

David Goodall reports: In the last 5 years, new research by the Liberal Democrats reveals the shocking number of post offices closed; nearly 2,200 or 12% of all UK Post Offices. This is part of the Government's "Post Office Urban Network Reinvention Programme" for those not speaking new Labour English this means "Post Office closure programme" Liberal Democrats believe good sub-Post Offices play a vital role in the community. Our policy is to support them by increasing the services provided.

And don't forget under the last Conservative Government 3334 post offices were shut.

Chris Huhne and the Lib Dems want to see MORE police on the street and MORE action on vandalism and anti-social behaviour.



Policy Point: Law & Order

Who really is "tough on crime & tough on the causes of crime" ?

The Liberal Democrats would have 10,000 more police officers, increase the number of support officers and cut out the petty paperwork. We would also introduce sentences that work. **Prison does not work;** 59% of prisoners are reconvicted within 2 years of release and 50% of all prisoners are at or below the reading level for an 11-year-old, this rises to 66% for maths and 80% for writing. Prisoners need **compulsory education** often missed earlier in life, they need **compulsory drug treatment** which continues on release. Non-violent offenders should be **compelled to 'pay back'** to victims and communities by carrying out work chosen by local people. One example is a pilot car repair scheme by the Liberal Democrat council in Liverpool that reduced 'joyriding' reoffences from 70% to just 7%.
